On June 9<sup>th</sup>, a Sikh girl's hair was cut by a classmate at P.S./M.S. 219 after months of teasing of her and her brother for being Sikhs.



The Sikh Coalition found that **65% of Sikh students in Queens report being teased or harassed** because of their Sikh identity.
