

# VOLUNTEER REBUILD RAPID BUILDING SUPPLIES

## WHO IS QUALIFIED FOR ASSISTANCE?

Any current New York City homeowner who is in SuperStorm Sandy Disaster Case Management (DCM) qualifies, regardless of FEMA approval or their immigration status. Any non-profit rebuild organization collaborating with a DCM must submit an itemized list of needed building supplies for any rebuild project, with two conditions.

- DCMs must simultaneously submit the homeowner's budget demonstrating unmet needs.
- The itemized building supply list must contain Home Depot SKU numbers and other appropriate details.

## WHAT IF A HOMEOWNER DOESN'T HAVE A DCM?

If Sandy impacted, CALL 855-258-0483 to get connected.

#### **HOW CAN HOMEOWNERS APPLY?**

Speak with DCM to determine eligibility. The DCM will complete the application after receipt of the completed building supply list.

### HOW DO DCMs SUBMIT BUILD SUPPLY LIST?

- Get trained by NYDIS. Email: unmetneeds@nydis.org.
- Get a Login & Password to the Application Portal.
- Log-in to www.unmetneedsroundtable.org.
- Submit Homeowner Name, Address, and Household Info. ONLY!
- Upload the building supply list (completed by the Volunteer Rebuilder) and the UNR Budget Form (must balance).
- Materials are ordered within 24 hours (Monday-Friday).
- Following the submission, DCMs will have three business days to submit a completed application to the UNR portal.
